Wednesday May 6th 1846

Light winds and fair weather, one sail
in sight middle part fair latter part squally
and rainy heading to the NE rounds NE

Thursday 7th

Strong winds and squally weather part
a ship standing to the South middle and
latter part fair part still in sight rounds

Friday 8th

Lat 41 m Long 128 10

Breeze trades and fair weather, mending
sails rounds this day Lat 8 m Long 128 16

Saturday 9th

Fresh trades fair weather heading SE by S
middle part wore ship to the NE latter
part saw a ship rounds Lat 38 m Long 127 36

Sunday 10th

Fresh trades and fair weather at 4 PM
spoke the Messenger Capt Jones 35 m
out 1400 lbs spun 100 middle and latter
part moderate winds ship heading SE the
messenger off our lee bow end

Monday 11

Lat 30 m Long 127 48

Breeze trades and fair weather heading
by the wind SE middle part wore ship
to the NE rounds Lat 28 m Long 127 23

Tuesday 12th

Strong winds and fair weather heading
NE middle and latter part the same

Wednesday 13

Lat 47 m Long 125 51

Strong winds and fair weather heading
NE by E middle and latter part the same
heading SE Lat 1.47 Long 125 28 m

Thursday 14th

Fresh trades and fair weather heading
SE middle and latter part light

Friday 15

Lat 2.34 Long 125 15

Light fair weather, steering SE middle and
latter part winds light heading SE employed
setting up and turning in the TB Day
Lat 3.01 Long 124 45

James Allen bound to the Eastward
Saturday May 16th 1846

Light winds and fair weather heading E by S
and SE found a current setting NNE miles
in lower middle part the same latter part
tacked to the South Lat 3.18 Long 124 29

Sunday 17th

Fresh winds and fair weather heading
SE by S middle part the same at 6 AM tacked
to the East rounds Lat 2.35 N Long none

Monday 18th

Fresh winds and fair weather at 5 PM
took again squall and light air from NW
at 6 PM half watched middle part heading
SE by S latter tacked to the E by N rounds saw
Porpoises Lat 2.30 Long 125 40

Tuesday 19th

Breeze trades and fair weather heading
E by S saw Porpoises middle winds light
latter part fresh winds heading SE by S rounds

Wednesday 20th

Lat 2.28 N Long 126 14

Strong winds and fair weather heading
SE by S middle part the same latter part heading
SE by S saw Porpoises Lat 1.18 N Long 127 27

Thursday 21st

Strong winds and fair weather heading
SE by S saw Blackfish middle and latter
part more moderate heading South

Friday 22nd

Lat 65 Long 128 32

Moderate winds and fair weather heading
SE by E middle and latter part the same
heading SE Lat 1.11 N Long 128 44

Saturday 23rd

Still moderate winds and fair weather
heading SE middle and latter part fair
and fresh winds at 9 AM saw whales
young W. H. M. low round struck Iron ~~Bar~~ the
whale went off at man a man came along
side whales in sight to windward
Lat 2.06 N Long 128 58
