Sunday May 31st 1846

Strong winds and fair weather, whales
still in sight middle and latter part just
winds sounds Lat 2.18 Long 128.46

Monday 25th

Strong winds and fair weather, at 4 Pm
saw whales going very fast to the N.E. by E
and not lower middle and latter part
strong winds some squally sounds

Tuesday 26th

Lat 2.40 Long 129.18

Strong winds some squally at 1 Pm saw
whales going to the N.E. by E chased
until dark without success whales very
wild, middle and latter part fresh winds
and fair weather, Lat 2.35 Long 129.41

Wednesday 27th

Strong winds and fair weather, heading
N.E. by E middle part the same at 6 Am saw
whales going quick to the N.E. by E chased at
meridian struck and killed 2 sounds

Thursday 28th

Lat 3.48 Long 129.36

Moderate winds and fair weather at
3 Pm took to the ship and began to cut at
6 fms below middle part clearing away the
latter strong winds and overcast weather, employed
boiling sounds Lat 3.54 Long 130.43

Friday 29th

Strong winds and overcast weather, boiling
ship heading N.E. by E middle and latter
part more moderate still boiling sounds

Saturday 30th

Lat 3.15 Long 130.24

Briske trades and fair weather, at 6 Pm
finished boiling ship heading N.E. by E middle
and latter part heading N.E. by E sounds

Sunday 31st

Lat 2.10 Long 129.51

Fresh winds and fair weather, middle and
latter part the same saw a shoal of Blackfish

Lat 1.8 Long 129.03

Monday 1st 1846

Strong winds heading by the winds N.E. by E
middle and latter, the same heading N.E. by E
Tuesday 2nd Lat 2.41 Long 128.47

Strong winds and fair weather, heading
N.E. by E middle part the same latter part squally
with strong winds heading N.E. by E Lat 4.43 Long 129.16

Wednesday 3rd

Strong winds and fair weather, heading
N.E. by E middle and latter, heading N.E. by E with
strong winds Lat 6.33 Long 129.18

Thursday 4th

Strong winds and fair weather, heading N.E.
middle and latter, part heading N.E. by E employed
mending sails Lat 8.46 Long 129.24

Friday 5th

Fresh winds and fair weather, heading
N.E. by E middle and latter, part the same
mending sails Lat 11.00 Long 129.19

Saturday 6th

Strong winds and fair weather, heading
N.E. by E middle and latter, the same steering
N.E. by E sounds on squall Lat 13.28 Long 129.29

Sunday 7th

Like strong trades course: N.E. by E middle
and latter, part the same heading N.E. by E sounds

Monday 8th

Lat 15.58 Long 129.00

Fresh winds and fair weather, heading
N.E. by E middle part N.E. by E latter part N.E.
winds out N.E. by E weather, fine sounds

Tuesday 9th

Lat 18.23 Long 128.25

Moderate and fine weather, course N.E.
middle winds from N.E. to N. latter part under
N.E. strong steering N.E. by E sounds Lat 19.55

Wednesday 10th

Long 126.44

Fresh winds and fair weather, heading
N.E. by E middle part the same latter part winds
casting to the N. by E on top of 8 (M. J. G. Pauls)
Lat 21.20 Long 124.09
