

James Allen bound to the East

Thursday June 11<sup>th</sup> 1846

Brisk North winds and clear weather  
course East by compass middle part winds  
NNE latter part winds N with rain  
Thursday bound course East Lat 22 15 Long 121 20

Strong winds from N and NNE and  
raining ship under single reef middle part  
calm at 3 AM took a light air from West latter  
part clear winds coming to the NNE winds

Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> Lat 22 15 Long 120 12

Moderate winds from South and clear weather  
steering E by S middle and latter part light  
winds from SSE ship heading East

Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> Lat 22 29 Long 119 06

Light winds from E by S and SE heading  
E by S at 8 PM tacked to the SE latter part the  
same sounds Lat 23 26 Long 119 39

Monday 15<sup>th</sup>

Light winds and fair weather heading  
SE wind E by S middle part winds shifted  
to the NE weather overcast latter part  
winds NNE a heavy swell from E by S course  
E by S by compass Lat 24 25 Long 117 00

Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup>

Strong NNE winds and cloudy steering  
E by S middle part heavy rain winds veered  
and hauls from N to NE ship under short sail  
latter part rain and strong winds from  
NNE steering E by S course Lat 25 10 Long 115 50

Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup>

Strong winds from NE and rainy heading  
E by S double reef middle part  
winds came to the N latter part light winds  
from NNE and clear Lat 26 22 Long 114 53

Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> Moderate winds from NNE and  
fair weather course East middle part  
winds increasing latter part strong winds and  
squally steering E by N Lat 26 50 Long 112 50

Friday June 19<sup>th</sup> 1846

Strong winds and cloudy weather steering  
E by N at sunset double reefed for Easter Island  
middle part winds hauled to the NNE some rain  
latter part fair at day light saw the Islands bearing  
SSE dist 18 miles kept off at 10 AM got to the land  
at midnight sent 2 boats in to trade for Yams  
and Potatoes sounds lying off and on Lat 27 06

Saturday 20<sup>th</sup>

Brisk winds and fine weather at 4 PM boats  
came along side with 10 bble yams and 6 Potatoes  
kept off to get clear of the land middle part  
light winds from SSE latter part the same saw  
the land at day light bearing N by S dist 35 mi

Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> Lat 27 03 Long 108 36

Begins with light air from SE and calm  
middle part took a light wind from West latter  
part increasing came to the NNE sounds weather fine

Monday 22<sup>nd</sup>

Brisk winds from N by N and fair weather  
course E by S by compass middle part the  
same latter part winds came to the NNE and  
rainy sounds Lat 28 01 Long 104 21

Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup>

Brisk winds and overcast weather course  
E by S by compass middle part the same  
latter part strong winds from NNE and squally  
course E by N Lat 28 09 Long 100 57

Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup>

Strong NNE winds and squally steering  
E by N took in the B Boat middle part strong  
winds latter part the same and squally course  
E by N Lat 28 00 Long 97 25

Thursday 25<sup>th</sup>

Strong NNE winds squally weather ship under  
double reef course E by N middle part the same  
latter part winds came to the SSE ship squally  
sounds steering E by N  
Lat 27 49 Long 94 40
