Friday June 26th 1846

Fresh S.E. winds and squally steering E by N
middle and latter part winds from E by South
and flaggy sounds making to the Eastward, sounds

Saturday 27th Lat 27 40 Long 92 17

Fresh S.E. winds and fair weather, steering by the
winds E by N middle and latter part moderate
winds from E by E and clear sounds

Sunday 28th Lat 27 07 Long 90 00

Light East winds and fair weather, at 4 P.M.
tacked to the S.E. middle part calms latter
part light N.W. winds and cloudy sounds

Monday 29th Lat 27 06 No Altitude

Brisk winds from N and overcast weather,
course E by N middle part the same latter part
winds from South and S.E. and rainy sounds

Tuesday 30th Lat 27 04 Long 86 48

Moderate winds from South and cloudy steering
E by N middle and latter part winds from N
to S.W. sounds Lat 26 47 Long 85 34

Wednesday July 1st 1846

Brisk winds from N to S and fair weather,
course E by N middle part winds veering from
S.E. to South latter part winds from East sounds

Thursday 2nd Lat 26 14 Long 83 40

Fresh winds from East and fair weather,
heading N.E. middle and latter part the
same Lat 25 00 Long 82 18

Friday 3rd

Fresh winds from E by S and cloudy weather,
heading N.E. by N middle part heading N.E. by E
latter part E by E Lat 23 49 Long 80 36

Saturday 4th

Strong S.E. trades heading E by N saw a Boat
heading to the South, middle and latter part
strong winds & saw a Boat steering N.W. sounds
cloudy Lat 23 05 Long 78 37

James Allen Bounds in Phoenix
Sunday July 5th 1846

Strong trades and overcast weather, course N.E.
middle and latter part the same at 9 A.M. saw
a Ship heading to the S.W. by the winds course N.E. by N

Monday 6th

Fresh winds from S by E and fair weather, steering
N.E. at sunset double reefed the topsails middle
and latter part moderate winds weather fair
course N by E Lat 19 35 Long 75 00

Tuesday 7th

Brisk winds from South and fair weather,
course N by E middle and latter part moderate
and cloudy saw Porpoises and Humpbacks

Wednesday 8th

Lat N Obs

Light trades and overcast weather, steering
N by E saw more Humpbacks at sunset hauled
the M. T. sail to the mast heading E by N by day
through night at daylight steered N by W sounds

Thursday 9th

Lat 17 45 Long 74 50

Moderate winds and cloudy steering N by W
saw Blackfish at sunset huffed to again aback
middle and latter part light winds saw 3 fish
and Porpoises Lat 17 00 Long 74 30

Friday 10th

Moderate trades and overcast at 5 P.M. saw
the main land bearing N.E. dist 40 miles
huffed to the wind heading E by N with the fore top
sail to the mast, middle part winds light at daylight
steered N by W saw 3 fish down Boat got 5 at 10 took
them to the ship sounds cloudy N Obs

Saturday 11th

Light winds and cloudy steering N by W
employed clearing away the B. fish at 2 P.M. saw
more sounds got 1 more middle part moderate
latter the same clouds got 4 Blackfish lands
15 miles dist sounds N Obs
