water fast track in the breakers sounds

Wednesday 19th at 3 P.M. took 14 cask along side
and hoisted them in latter part took a
raft up the river sounds

Thursday 20th Employed filling water & latter
part getting and stowing away water

Friday 21st

At 3 P.M. took a raft to the Ship and
hoisted it in latter part sent a raft up
the river &c

Saturday 22nd At 5 P.M. took the last raft off
latter employed stowing water sounds

Sunday 23rd At 4 P.M. took the Anchor at 10 thro
to sea latter part fair sounds

M.M. at 5 P.M. saw 10 Whales going quick
to the South bound without success middle
part small rains latter part fair sounds

Breeze heads and fair weather steering
M.M. by M middle part by the winds latter
part steering M.M. by M at 10 A.M. saw Whatham
Islands bearing M.M. dist. 20 m sounds

Monday 31st

Lat 1.53 Long

Fresh winds and fair weather heading
by the winds M.M. at sunset the M.M. end of
Whatham bore M.M. by M dist 15 m middle
part working over toward Charles Islands
at daylight 6 o'clock bearing 1/2 N dist 20 m
at 7 saw Garden's Island 10 m dist sounds

Tuesday Sept 1st 1846

Moderate winds and fair weather Garden
9.6 m dist at 6 P.M. tacked to the S.E.
middle part cloudy latter part fair Charles
Islands 20 m dist Lat 1.32 Long 96.28

Wednesday 2nd

Light winds and fair weather at sunset
Charles Islands bearing M.M. by M dist 25 m
middle part heading in for the sounds latter
part the same Lat Long

Thursday 3rd

Light winds and fair weather standing
in for Black Buoys at 3 P.M. sent a Boat
in to get Potatoes at 8 the Boat returned
without Potatoes latter part thick running
down for M.M. Lat 1.19 Long

Friday 4th

Light winds and fair weather M.M. at
15 miles dist saw Blackfish and a seal
middle part by the winds at 9.16 at 8 A.M.
sent 2 Boats in search of Tinian & Ship
lying off and on 2 hours in sight Lat 1.18
