sails middle and latter part the same

Friday 16th Lat 4 38 Long 109 38

Strong trades and fine weather,
middle and latter part the same at 7
AM saw Whales and Blackfish and
Porpoises at 10 hours sounds Lat 4 43 S 110 22

Saturday 17th Brisk winds one ship in sight
at 2 PM struck and killed one at 4
took to the ship middle part lying
by the whale at daylight hooked one sound
cutting Lat 4 48 Long 111 04

Sunday 18th

Strong winds and fair weather, employed
cutting at 4 PM finished middle part
charting away latter part boiling heads

Monday 19th Lat 4 51 Long 111 7

Strong winds with fresh flakes employed
boiling heads latter part boiling body

Tuesday 20th Lat 4 38 Long 111 11

Strong winds and fair weather,
boiling middle and latter part the same

Wednesday 21st Lat 4 58 Long 111 27

Strong winds at 2 PM finished boiling
middle and latter part strong winds
saw Porpoises Lat 4 25 Long 111 67

Friday 23rd Lat 5 31 Long 111 32

Strong winds and fair weather, saw
a Phil to windward middle and latter

Strong winds and fair weather, finished
Coopering mast middle and latter part
the same one pair in sight Lat 4 26 Long 111 5

Sunday 25th Strong winds and fair weather, middle
and latter part the same Lat 4 41 Long 111

Monday 26th

Fresh winds and fair weather, at 3
PM spoke the Abagar 1100 Pm 300 Mhals
middle and latter part strong winds
all the day storming down Lat 5 07 Long 111 50

Tuesday 27th

Strong winds and fair weather, employed
storming down middle and latter
part the same the Abagar in sight

Wednesday 28th Lat 5 01 Long 111 20

Strong winds and fair weather, finished
storming down middle and latter part
strong winds Lat 5 07 Long 111 45

Thursday 29th

Strong winds and equally middle
and latter part strong winds and fair

Friday 30th Lat 4 21 Long

Strong winds and fair weather, middle
part the same latter part equally sounds

Saturday 31st Lat 4 44 Long
