Fresh winds saw a ship cutting middle middle part saw her boiling latter fresh winds Lat 5.3 Long 111 13

Wednesday 4th

Fresh winds at 5 P.M. saw whales going quick to E to near night for us middle and latter part fine at 11 A.M. saw more whales going quick to windward

Thursday 5th

Fresh winds and fine weather at 1/2 past 12 lowered in chaise at 3 returned no whales saw Porpoise middle part light rains latter fair Lat 5.24 Long 111 08

Friday 6th Fresh winds and fair weather, saw Porpoise middle and latter part fine

Saturday 7th

Fresh winds and squally middle and latter part fair Lat 5.10 Long 110 18

Sunday 8th

Fresh winds and fair weather, middle part the same at 8 A.M. saw a ship & whale sounds whales in sight Lat 4.44 Long 110.8

Monday 9th

Fresh winds whales still in sight at 5 P.M. lowered struck Iron Saw whales went off middle and latter part fine sounds Lat 4.25 Long 110 05

Tuesday 10th Light winds and fine weather

Wednesday 11th Lat 5.02 Long 110 02

Thursday 12th part the same Lat 4.48 Long 109 41

Moderate at 1 P.M. struck 8 fms do 3 at 11 P.M. took the last one to the ship middle part by the whales at 2 A.M. part fine fine bound a boat and took her along side at daylight took some as cutting

Saturday 14th

Lat 4.54 Long 110 12

Light winds and fine weather at 2 P.M. finished cutting and cleared the decks at 2 A.M. began to boil latter part fine boiling

Sunday 15th

Lat

Moderate winds and fine weather, employed boiling middle and latter part the same

Monday 16th

Lat 5.06 Long 110 08

Brisk trades fine weather, employed boiling middle and latter part the same saw Porpoise and Blackfish

Tuesday 17th

Lat 4.49 Long 109 34

Brisk winds at 1 P.M. finished boiling middle and latter part fine setting up P.M. for this first time Lat 5.00 Long 109 26

Wednesday 18th

Brisk winds and clear, middle middle and latter part the same

Thursday 19th

Lat 5.9 Long 109 42

Fresh trades saw Porpoise middle and latter part the same Lat 4.56 Long 109 3

Friday 20th

Fresh trades middle and latter

part the same at daylight saw whales close to the ship lowered whales called no use

Saturday 21st

Lat 4.59 Long 108 50

Fresh winds & at 3 P.M. past a ship standing to the N.E. middle at 7 A.M. saw whales at 9 lowered sounds boats in chase Lat 4.59 Long 109 25
