Sunday Dec 13th 1846

Light winds and fine weather all this day saw Jimps Lat 4 35 Long 107 17

Monday 14th

Moderate trades all this 24 hours one sail in the East Lat 5 09 Long 107 49

Tuesday 15th

Breeze trades one sail in sight middle and latter part fine saw Finbacks

Wednesday 16th

Lat 5 22 Long 107 47

Breeze trades at 4 P.M. spoke the John Adams Macks 28 m out 8.00 P.M. middle and latter part fine 1 A in sight

Thursday 17th

Lat 5 33 Long 106 50

All this 24 hours fine weather at 8 A.M. saw whales going West lower do struck and killed one sound Lat 4 46 Long 106 30

Friday 18th

Strong winds at 1 P.M. took the whale along side at 3 hooked on at 6 made off middle part bying by the whale one

Ship in sight at daylight began to cut the Board at meridian finished sound

Saturday 19th

Lat 5 44

Breeze trades employed clearing away the case &c middle

latter part boiling head saw Finbacks Lat 5 03 Long 106 20

Sunday 20th

Light trades employed boiling middle and latter part the same one sail in sight Lat 4 50 Long 105 51

Monday 21st

Light winds employed boiling at 4 P.M. spoke the Oregon Capt

Whimping 18 m out 1000 lbs at 6 finished boiling middle and latter cloudy winds

Tuesday 22nd

Lat 4 47 Long 105 27

Breeze trades all this 24 hours Lat 4 58 Long 105 33

Wednesday Dec 23rd 1846

Light trades and fair weather all this 24 hours Lat 4 48 Long 106 04

Thursday 24th

Moderate trades and cloudy all this day Lat 5 23 Long 105 45

Friday 25th

Fresh trades and overcast weather saw Porpoises Lat 5.8 Long 105 00

Saturday 26th

Fresh trades and cloudy at 3 P.M. saw whales lower do killed 2 things so they go off middle and latter part fine whales saw Porpoises Lat 4 53 Long 104 50

Sunday 27th

Strong trades and fine all this 24 hours Lat 5 10 Long 104 30

Monday 28th

Fresh trades and fair saw Porpoises middle and latter part the same

Tuesday 29th

Lat 4 45 Long 104 09

Fresh trades and fair middle and latter part the same at 8 A.M. saw whales going slowly to windward at 9 lower do sounds in chase Lat 4 35 Long 104 08

Wednesday 30th

Light trades and clear at 1 P.M. struck and killed 2 at 4 took them along side middle part bying by the whales at daylight hooked two saw Finbacks sounds cutting Lat 4 38 Long 104 50

Thursday 31st

Moderate and fine at 6 P.M. finished BAD cutting middle part boiling latter part

BAD

this same Lat 5 05 Long 105 05

Friday Jan 1st 1847

Moderate trades and fair at 5 P.M. finished boiling head middle and latter part fine employed boiling Lat 4 36 Long 104 19
