and latter part fine Lat 4 31 Long 94 27

Tuesday 26th Light winds saw Porpoises
middle and latter part wind
light Lat 4 31 Long 95 11

Wednesday 27th

Light winds middle part the same
saw 2 Bone Charks Lat 4 48 Long 93 18

Thursday 28th

Strong winds heading N by E middle
and latter part moderate Lat 5 52 Long 92 19

Friday 29th

Boat Brisk trades saw Black fish and Porpoises

Saturday 30th middle and latter part the same
Lat 3 17 Long 92 30

Light winds one ship in sight
all these 24 hours saw a Ternapodite
Brig steering N by E Lat

Sunday 31st

Light winds one ship in sight
middle part rainy latter part fair

Monday Feb 1st 1847 No Obs

Light winds heading E by N middle
part the same latter part fresh winds

Tuesday 2nd Lat 2 38 Long 90 24

Boat Brisk trades steering N by E saw Porpoises
middle part by the winds latter part
saw Charles Island bearing N by N
saw one ship Lat 1 41

Off the Galapagos Islands
Wednesday Feb 3rd 1847

Moderate winds Charles Island 15 m
dist saw a Boat middle and latter part
moderate 6 Land 15 m dist one sailing

Thursday 4th

Light winds at 5 P.M. came to anchor
in Post office Bay in 8 fathoms water
latter part washing ship

Friday 5th

Employed washing ship latter
part painting in side sounds

Saturday 6th

Fine weather at 4 P.M. finished
painting in side & latter part painting
out side one Boat to Black Bucho

Sunday 7th

Employed painting out side
at 6 P.M. finished painting latter part
one watch on liberty

Monday 8th

Fine weather one watch on liberty
latter part 1 Match on liberty sounds

Tuesday 9th

Calm and clear watch on liberty
at 7 P.M. all returned latter part getting
ready for sea

Wednesday 10th Waiting for a wind
all ready for sea at 5 A.M. took
the Anchor and towed out the harbour
sounds calm

Thursday 11th Light winds heading N by E
middle part calm latter part light
winds Beating up towards Gardens Is.

Friday 12th

Light winds at sunset 1 Island bore
N by E and Gardens I. N by E middle
part calm latter part light winds from
S by E and S by E saw Black fish Gardens
Island bearing N by E Lat 1 44 Long 89 50
