Light winds heading by E employed
throwing out in After No. 10 latter part
finished saw Garopias and Porpoises

Thursday 4th Lat 3.3. Long 87 24

Light winds ships heading I saw
Porpoises middle part some rain
latter part the same at midnight saw
whales sounds Lat 3.20 Long 87 30

Friday 5th

Brisk winds at 12 M down boats
struck and killed one at 3 took
to the ship middle part some rain
at daylight hooked on at 10 finished
sounds far Lat 3.49 Long 87 16

Saturday 6th Light from E N E heading E
boiling latter part heading N E
saw Porpoises Lat N Oils

Sunday 7th

Light winds heading N E boiling
middle part finished latter part
squally saw a ship steering S P M sounds

Monday 8th Lat 3 49 Long 86 47

Light winds from E N E heading E
also saw in sight middle and latter
part squally Lat 4.31 Long 86 21

Tuesday 9th

Brisk winds from East heading
S P E squally middle and latter
part winds baffling frequent rain
squally saw Blackfish and Porpoises

Wednesday 10th

No Obs
Light baffling winds and squally
saw Finbacks ship heading E by S
middle and latter part the same
saw plenty Blackfish

Thursday March 11th 1847

Baffling winds and squally saw
Blackfish middle and latter part
squally heading E by N Lat 4 53 Long 83 53

Friday 12th

Begins squally middle and latter
part the same saw B F Lat 4 38 Long 83 45

Saturday 13th

Light winds employed Porpoising S. P. M
middle part brisk winds at 6 A M saw
whales going to the S P M found galled
struck from traps patches whale went off
Lat 4 18 Long 83 29

Sunday 14th

Brisk trades heading E N E saw
Blackfish middle and latter part
saw more ship heading East

Monday 15th

Lat 3 58 Long 82 38

Fresh winds heading E by N
middle and latter part heading
East saw Blackfish Lat 3 58 Long 81 43

Tuesday 16th

Strong winds from South employed
stowing pipes at sunset shortened
sail middle and latter part calm saw
a Steamboat running South Lat 4 00 Long 81 09

Wednesday 17th

Calm saw Blackfish middle
part light winds at daylight saw
the North part of Cape Blanco bearing
E P E dist 20 M. saw B Fishes got 2 porpoises

Thursday 18th

Lat 4 03 Long 80 56

Brisk trades steering E N E at sunset
Point Malpelo bore E N E dist 15 M
dist looks in Top galut sails and masted
middle part light winds latter looks
from the North saw 3 small crafts and
spoke a catamaran 5 days from Guayaquil
