Sunday May 9th 1847

Moderate winds several ships in sight middle and latter part the same Lat 4.39 Long 103 14

Monday 10th

Light winds steering G.M. 2 ships in sight middle part by the wind latter part by the wind saw 1 ship Lat 4.59 Long 103 26

Tuesday 11th

Briske winds steering G.M. one ship in sight middle part by the wind latter part steering N.W. Lat 4.51 Long 103 54

Wednesday 12th

Strong winds steering G.M. saw 3 ships middle by the wind under double reefed 2 sails latter part steering N.W. saw 1 ship Lat 4.30

Thursday 13th

Moderate winds course G.M. middle part by the wind latter part steering G.M. Lat 4.30 Long 103 08

Friday 14th

Friske trades steering G.M. middle part by the wind latter part running off at midnight spoke the Bark Winslow Capt Simons 25 ms out 250 M 250 Gpm

Saturday 15th

Lat 5 12 Long 106 40
Steering off at sunset spoke the Bark again middle part by the wind latter part running off the Bark in sight Lat 5 26

Sunday 16th

Strong winds and squally a Bark in sight middle part by the wind latter part angling off saw a Bark Lat 4.48 Long 108

Monday 17th

Strong winds and squally middle part the same latter part saw a sail Lat 4.50 Long 108 49

Off Shore

Tuesday May 18th 1847

Strong winds steering N.N.W. at sunset shifted to the wind under short sails latter part steering G.M. Lat 4.52 Long 109 32

Wednesday 19th

Friske winds steering G.M. middle by the wind latter part the same Lat 5 50 Long 110 02

Thursday 20th

Strong winds heading G by the wind middle heading to the N.E. back latter part steering N.N.W. Lat 5 40 Long 110 48

Friday 21st

Friske winds steering N.N.W. middle by the wind latter part began to run off at 7 A.M. saw whales going to the S.E. none struck two got on one line parted sounds equally Lat 4.34 Long 110 50

Saturday 22nd

Strong winds at 3 P.M. took the whale along side at 4 broke on at dark had off and 2 pieces in middle by the whale at daylight began to cut again at 8 finished Lat 4.50 Long 111 13

Sunday 23rd

Light winds and fine weather employed boiling middle and latter part the same Lat 4.39 Long 111 00

Monday 24th

Light winds heading to the N.E. at 4 P.M. finished boiling middle and latter part fine Lat 4.48 Long 111 23

Tuesday 25th

Friske winds and fair weather middle and latter part moderate light winds middle and latter part strong winds nothing in sight

Wednesday 26th

Lat 5 11 Long 112 28
