Thursday May 27th 1847

Strong winds and squally middle and latter part the same Lat 44^o 49' Long 112^o 35'

Friday 28th

Strong winds and fair weather middle and latter part moderate squalls

Saturday 29th

Lat 51^o 18' Long 112^o 50'

Moderate winds and fine weather middle and latter part squally with strong winds Lat 43^o 39'

Sunday 31st

Strong winds nothing in sight middle and latter part the same Lat 43^o 31' 113^o 58'

Monday 31st

Strong trades all the 24 hours saw Koller's corals Lat 50^o Long

Tuesday June 1st 1847

Strong winds nothing seen middle and latter part the same Lat 54^o 52' 115^o 47'

Wednesday 2nd

Strong trades all the 24 hours

Thursday 3rd

Lat 50^o 2' Long 115^o 10'

Strong trades now bound to the sun middle and latter part moderate Lat 3^o 53' Long 114^o 10'

Friday 4th

Moderate winds heading N.E. middle part the same latter part squally heading from N. to N.E. Lat 3^o 5' Long 115^o 17'

Saturday 5th

BAD but fresh winds heading N.N.E. middle and latter part the same

Sunday 6th

Lat 1^o 38' 113^o 37'

Do. Fresh winds heading N.E. saw Finbacks middle and latter part the same Lat 52^o Long 111^o 52'

Monday 7th

Do. Fresh trades middle and latter part moderate Lat 30^o Long 110^o 27'

On the line

Tuesday June 8th 1847

BAD Light winds heading E by N at 2 P.M. saw whales at 4 hours at 6 struck Iron drew whale store the Boat middle part heading to the E.N.E. latter part the same Lat 30^o Long 109^o 36'

Wednesday 9th

Do Light winds course E.N.E. middle and latter part the same Lat 12^o M. Long 107^o 56'

Thursday 10th

BAD Moderate winds heading S by W saw Porpoises middle and latter part the same Lat 20^o M. Long 107^o 45'

Friday 11th

Do Strong Easterly current heading S by E middle part heading N.E. latter part S Lat 17^o M. Long 106^o 49'

Saturday 12th

Do Fresh winds heading S middle and latter part the same Lat 11^o 6' 106^o 22'

Sunday 13th

Do Fresh winds and clear middle and latter part strong winds saw Finbacks and Porpoises Lat 23^o 6' Long 105^o 21'

Monday 14th

Do Strong winds heading South all the 24 hours Lat 34^o 7' Long 106^o 50'

Tuesday 15th

BAD Strong trades heading South middle part the same at 6 A.M. saw whales young specks to the East found in chaska without success Lat 43^o 39' Long 107^o 24'

Wednesday 16th

Do Fresh winds heading S by E saw Finbacks middle and latter part the same Lat 5^o 16' Long 107^o 12'
