Thursday June 17th 1847

Strong winds at 3 P.M. saw whales
going quick to the SE middle part
heading to the NE at daylight saw
a Ship's Landing to the NE saw 3 Fish
Porpoises and 4 Furbacks and 4 Rampuses

Friday 18th

Lat 45 6 Long 107 14

Strong winds heading to the NE
middle part the same at daylight were
ships at 10 A.M. saw whales going quick to
the NE sounds Lat 45 6 Nobs

Saturday 19th

At 2 P.M. down Boats at 4 struck
and killed one at 5 took to the Ship
and hauled forward to the NE at daylight
commenced cutting at 11 A.M. finished
and stood to the SE saw Furbacks and 3 or 4

Sunday 20th Lat 43 8 Long 107 13

Moderate winds and fine weather
at 4 P.M. began to Bore saw plenty
Porpoises middle and latter part
moderate saw a ship Lat 43 7 Long 107 15

Monday 21st

Light winds at 7 P.M. finished
boring middle and latter part
moderate Lat 44 3 Long 107 18

Tuesday 22nd

Moderate winds 2 Ships in sight
middle and latter part the same
employed breaking out the after Hold

Wednesday 23rd Lat Long 107 31

Light winds at 4 P.M. spoke
the Corals Capt. Peabury J.M. out
250 Hbls middle and latter part
moderate saw Black fish

Lat 5 16 Long 107 30

Off Thore

Thursday June 24th

Moderate winds at 3 P.M. spoke
the Corals again middle and latter
part strong winds 2 Ships in sight one
whaling sounds Lat 45 2 Long 107 25

Friday 25th

Strong winds 2 Ships in sight middle
and latter part the same at 11 A.M.
saw whales going quick to the SE lower
in chase without success sounds

Saturday 26th Lat 45 9

Breeze winds at 2 P.M. boats
returned middle and latter part
moderate saw Porpoises Lat 45 9 Long 106 16

Sunday 27th

Moderate winds saw Furbacks
middle and latter part the same
one Ship in sight saw Furbacks 3 Porpoises

Monday 28th Lat 45 10 Long 107 16

Breeze winds 2 ships in sight
middle and latter part the same
1 Ship in sight Lat 45 1 Long 107 10

Tuesday 29

Breeze winds 1 ship in sight middle
and latter part the same

Wednesday 30th Lat 43 3 Long 106 54

Breeze trades saw Furbacks latter
part 3 Ships in sight Lat 50 9 Long 107 14

Thursday July 1st 1847

Breeze trades 2 Ships in sight one
whaling middle and latter part
fine Lat 51 9 Long

Friday 2nd

Fresh winds one ship in sight
middle and latter part Strong
winds at 9 A.M. saw whales going
to the South at 10 found middle and
so they go off to windward
Lat 51 8 Long 106 54
