Monday August 9th 1847

Strong winds from S by W and
overcast weather middle and
latter part the same Lat 46 N S 82 W

Tuesday 10th

Strong winds heading E by E saw
a Ship and a Brig middle and
latter part the same Lat 46 N S 81.38

Wednesday 11th

Strong winds heading E our sails
in sight middle and latter part
the same Lat 46 N S 81.38

Thursday 12th

Light winds heading E saw
plenty of upbacks and B Fishes found
caught one B Fish saw a sail and
saw Point St Helena bearing N N E
middle and latter part light winds
heading E by S Lat 3 06 Long 80 58

Friday 13th

Light winds from W by N steering
S by E saw a Ship and a Brig middle
part saw the land at daylight off
Point Pico 3 Ships in sight Lat 3 57 Long 80 45

Saturday 14th

Light winds at 3 P.M. spoke the
manner Capt Ray 36 fr m out
16 or 400 Whale middle part lying
off and on at daylight steering
a land course Lat

Sunday 15th

Light winds running the land
down at 6 P.M. came to anchor
in 7 fathoms then Bar bearing
E N E dist 4 miles middle part
risky winds at 8 A.M. got under
way at 11 came to anchor in 7 fathoms
Roberts in 5 fathoms water found
the Edw. Pallas and Accusmet

Inc. Tumbes

Monday Aug 16th 1847

Broke wind as nothing strong
at 4 A.M. sent the raft in at 9
took it along sides and commenced
stowing ~~the~~ stows

Tuesday 17th

Employed stowing water at
5 sent in the second raft to be filled
in the morning at 5 Boats left the
Ship to fill the raft at 9 took it along
sides stowing water

Wednesday 18th

Employed washing ships latter
part painting water and bands
and watches on liberty for three days

Thursday 19th

Painting the waist latter part the
same

Friday 20th Very little doing latter getting
off Potatoes and Drunken

Saturday 21st

Painting the latter part getting off
Potatoes

Sunday 22nd Getting ready for sea middle
part saw a latter part our watches on liberty

Monday 23rd

Found water latter part getting off
Potatoes

Tuesday 24th Getting ready for sea
Wednesday 25th

All ready for sea at 7 A.M. took
the anchor and stood to sea

Thursday 26th

Frishtoads heading N by N
2 Ships in sight middle and latter
part strong winds Lat 3 00 Long 82 07

Friday 27th Strong winds course West middle
part by the wind latter part steering
N by E saw Frigate B Fish & Fusel
Lat 2 36
