Sunday Sept 12<sup>th</sup> 1847

Strong winds steering S by middle part by the NE latter part steering S by M at 9 AM saw whales going quick to the lower part of the 21 lat 43 34 S 101 26

Monday 13<sup>th</sup> Strong winds and equally saw Finbacks middle and latter part fresh winds lat 45 42 S 101 57

Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> Strong winds angling off middle part by the wind at 7 AM saw a sail at 9 spoke in the Sredmoy Capt Taber 11 ms out 6 or rounded lat 43 32 S 101 41

Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> Strong winds in company with the Sredmoy middle part by the wind to the NE latter part the same

Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> Strong winds heading to the NE saw 5 Paul middle and latter part moderate saw Porpoises & Finbacks

Friday 17<sup>th</sup> Light winds all the 24 hours saw Finbacks and Porpoises lat Long

Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> Light winds and fine weather middle part lying with the M to the NE latter part steering S by M lat 50 1 Long 103 16

Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> Light winds and fine weather saw Blackfish and Grampuses middle and latter part fine

Monday 20<sup>th</sup> Moderate winds steering S by middle part by the wind latter part steering S by M lat 50 4 Long 104 50

Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> 1847

Brisk winds angling off saw a ship middle part by the wind latter part steering S by M lat 45 52 Long 105 40

Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> Moderate trades and fine weather course S by middle part by the wind at daylight steering N at 8 AM saw whales going to the NE lower end of the at midnight struck line parted; whales went off rounds lat 53 31 S 105 50

Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> Fresh winds at 3 PM took up the boats middle and latter part by the wind lat 51 42 Long

Friday 24<sup>th</sup> Moderate trades at 4 PM saw a whale going to the NE the did not lower middle and latter part fresh winds lat 50 9 Long 104 29

Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> Fresh trades saw Porpoises and Sulphur Bottoms middle part by the wind latter part steering N by M saw Finbacks lat 54 6 S

Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> Brisk trades and fine weather at 3 PM saw a whale going slowly to the NE by M lower end struck line and took to the ship middle part lying by the whale at 6 AM hooked on at midnight still cutting lat 54 9 S 105 42

Monday 27<sup>th</sup> Moderate winds and fine weather at 4 PM fresh cutting middle part began to bail latter part lying saw Finbacks lat 53 1 Long 107
