Fine weather employed as boring middle and latter part strong winds still boring Lat 52 62 Long 107 17

Wednesday 29th

Strong winds employed as boring middle part finished boring latter part washing off saw a ship

Thursday 30th Lat 50 62 Long 107 11

Strong winds at 4 30 m spoke the Balena 23 mo out 15 50 middle and latter part squally saw 13 eagles

Friday Oct 1st 1847

Strong winds and squally all the 24 hours employed as boring Lat 50 62

Saturday 2nd Strong and squally all the 24 hours Lat 55 22 Long 108 50

Sunday 3rd

Strong winds and squally employed as boring middle and latter part squally No Ob.

Monday 4th

Strong winds and squally middle and latter part more moderate saw a ship Lat 43 0 Long

Tuesday 5th

Strong winds heading to the South middle and latter part strong winds saw 3 Barks and 3 porpoises

Wednesday 6th Lat 44 22 Long 107 19

Strong winds and fine weather all these 24 hours saw 3 porpoises

Thursday 7th

Lat 44 44 Long 107 10

For the wind at 4 30 m past a ship steering to the N.E. middle and latter part strong winds saw 3 porpoises and 3 black birds Lat 50 22 Long 106 57

Off Shore

Friday Oct 8th 1847

Strong winds heading I saw a ship to the N.E. middle and latter part the same ship in sight Lat 52 22 Long 107 20

Saturday 9th

Strong winds and fine weather all these 24 hours at 10 A.M. past the Balena a ship as Lat 45 9 Long 106 47

Sunday 10th

Strong winds and middle and latter part moderate saw 2 Furbacks

Monday 11th

Lat 45 9 Long 106 43

Light wind and fine weather all these 24 hours Lat 53 0 Long

Tuesday 12th

Light winds steering N by E middle part by the wind latter part steering N by E Lat 51 0 Long 107

Wednesday 13th

Strong winds steering N by E middle part by the wind latter part steering N by E Lat

Thursday 14th

Moderate trades angling off middle part by the wind latter part steering North Lat 44 55 Long 107 35

Friday 15th

Strong winds ~~the~~ ships in sight at 5 30 m spoke the James Cooper 10 mo out 30 00 middle part by the wind latter part steering North saw Furbacks Lat 45 52 Long 108 24

Saturday 16th

Moderate winds angling off middle part by the wind latter part steering N by E saw Furbacks Lat 45 58 Long 108 33
