weather, course S. by N. middle part the
same at 5 A. M. winds blew to the S. by E. and
blew a S. by E. breeze ship heading S. N. by compass

Sunday 27th Lat 44 37 Long 84 25

Fresh S. by E. winds and fair weather, ship
heading S. N. middle part moder. latter
part calm saw a Bark standing to the S. by E.

Monday 28th Lat 44 33 Long 85 25

Begins light and calm ship heading
S. by E. middle and latter part the same one
ship in sight Lat 44 50 Long 85 40

Tuesday 29th Light winds from S. N. & S. by E. course

S. by E. and sail in sight middle and
latter part winds light from N. N. W. and
B. by E. and sail in sight

Moderate N. N. W. winds steering
S. by E. by A. mending a topsail

Thursday 3rd Lat 47 34 Long 84 35

Breeze N. N. W. winds course S. by E. &
carrying Royals and studding sails
middle part rain latter part broad casts
to the west and clear off Lat 49 40 Long 83 22

Friday 5th

Strong N. by E. winds and fair weather
course S. by E. under all possible sails middle
and latter part thick some rain

Saturday 6th Lat by Act 52 20 Long 81 59

Fresh S. N. winds and fair weather
course S. E. middle part steered S. by E.
winds came to the N. N. W. latter, wind
from N. N. W. ship running under M. topsails
and main top sail set and fore sail close
up and fore topsail. No weather thick
and rainy. Lat by Act 54 57
Long by Act 79 24

As Fast as Possible

Sunday March 5th 1848

Strong N. N. W. winds and thick rainy
weather steering S. by E. under M. and fore
M. top sail set fore sail & close reefed
fore topsail middle part shortened sails
wind increasing at 6 A. M. took in all but
close reefed M. topsails and fore the ship
too heading S. N. at 7 took in the M. topsails
and set the main spruce, & wind blowing
heavy Lat 55 55 Long 77 00

Monday 6th

Strong B. by E. from West by N. too under
main spruce & fore topsails, at 8 A. M. kept
off S. by E. under fore sail and fore topsails
middle part more moderate made
some sail latter part made sails and
steered S. E. Lat 57 23 Long 67 02

Tuesday 7th

The strong winds from west at midnight
kept off S. by E. to make an East corner,
carrying fore topsail. Theudding sails, middle
and latter part the same course S. by E.

Wednesday 8th

Strong N. by E. winds, running S. by E.
by compass at 7 P. M. past a ship standing
to the N. N. W. by the wind middle and
latter part strong winds and squally
latter part course S. by E. by compass carrying
studding sails and royals Lat 57 00 Long 66 36

Thursday 9th

Strong S. N. winds and squally at 2 P. M.
saw 2 ships and a Bark standing by the
wind to the N. N. W. ship carrying studding
and Royals middle and latter thick and
squally at 5 A. M. past a Bark heading to the
south at 11 saw Staten Island bearing
N. N. W. at 12 saw a ship heading to the S. N.
winds Lat 55 30
Long 63 00
