Saturday 25th Lat 35 53 Long 42 44

Strong South Gale and squally course
N E middle part winds came to the
S W latter part more moderate winds

Sunday 26th Lat 33 40 Long 40 33

Moderate S W winds and fair weather
course N E middle part the same
latter part light and a calm

Monday 27th Lat 32 52 Long by act 39 34

Light and a calm middle part
took a haul from E N E latter part the
same with squalls Lat 32 08 Long 39 35

Thursday 28th

Fresh winds from N E by E and cloudy
heading N by N middle part the same
latter part heading East by the wind
from N N E Lat 31 24 Long 39 03

Friday 29th

Strong N E by E winds and cloudy
weather heading to the N by N middle
and latter part calm employed fitting
rigging Lat 31 35 Long 39 05

Thursday 30th

Light and a calm middle and
latter part moderate winds from N W
course N E by E saw a fog steering by
the wind to the N W Lat 29 42 Long 38 15

Friday 31st

Breeze winds from West and fine
weather course N E by E middle part
the same at 8 A.M. took a squally carrying
away Fore Top Gale standing sail to room
Lat 28 38 Long 36 09

Saturday Apr 1st 1848

Moderate S W winds and fine weather
course N E by N middle part calm
latter part calm Lat 28 00 Long 35 50

Sunday 2nd

Breeze calm middle part took a light
to haul from E N E at 3 A.M. wind hauled
to the N by N latter part squally heading
N E by E and N E Lat 27 00 Long 34 59

Monday 3rd

Strong winds from N N W and N W
course N N E middle part winds came to
the S W latter part from S W Lat 25 12 Long 33 50

Tuesday 4th

Strong S W winds and fair weather
course N N E middle and latter part
more moderate saw a sail standing
to the N W and steering N E by N

Wednesday 5th

Breeze South winds and fine weather
course N N E middle part the same
latter part strong breeze and sail in sight

Thursday 6th

Strong E S E winds and fair weather
two sail in sight course N E by N
middle and latter part thick and
rainy winds from East & N E a sail in
sight Lat by act 18 22 Long 33 04

Friday 7th

Buffing winds and rainy a fog in
sight middle and latter part the same

Saturday 8th

Breeze squally and rainy and sail in sight
middle part the same latter part
Lat 15 40 Long 32 40
