Montgomery from the coast of Africa bound
to Philadelphia sounds waiting weather to paint

Friday 7th

Strong East winds and fair weather middle
part wind came to this S.E. latter part the
same Lat 22 31 Long 52 40

Saturday 8th

Strong S.E. winds and fair weather
course N.W. watching a chance to paint
ships middle part fair latter part cloudy
began to paint out side and in sounds

Sunday 9th

Brisk S.E. winds and fair weather
at 3 P.M. commenced to rain the paint off
course N.W. middle part light rain
latter part fair employed painting

Monday 10th

Strong S.E. winds and fair weather
at sunset began to rain a little latter
part fair paint out side and in course N.W.

Tuesday 11th

Moderate S.E. and fair weather with
the exceptions of a few light squalls of rain
over middle and latter part fair painting
ships course N.W. by N Lat 27 42 Long 59 19

Wednesday 12th

Moderate S.E. winds and fair weather
saw a Gopher headed to this S.W. middle
and latter part fine painting &c
