Tuesday Dec 7th 1877

Had fresh breezes from the S.W. the greater part of this day ended the main stay sail & storm tugged nothing more & had

Lat 44° 23'

Long 57° 13'

Wednesday 8th

This day began with fresh breeze from the West vessel steering S.W. by W. mid part wind hauled into the S. and at 40 latter part calm made new fore & main and done several other small jobs and the vessel saw a sail

Lat 44° 35'

Long 55° 23'

Thursday 9th

Breeze sprang up from the S. and hauled from vessel steering S.W. by W. all the first part. Mid part wind hauled out S.W. squally nothing of note occurred.

Friday 10th

Had clear weather and steady breeze from the S.W. vessel steering into the Westward the greater part of this day

Lat 45° 16'

Long 59° 29'

Saturday 11th

Had moderate breezes from the S.W. during the first part. Mid part wind from the S.W. & at latter part strong breeze from S.W. as usual

To Cape Horn

Monday Dec 10th 1877

Had strong breezes from the S.W. the greater part of this day vessel working into the Westward

Lat 44° 54'

Long 62° 53'

Tuesday 11th

Wind moderated and vessel ran the West vessel steering S.W. under an air. caught a few fish

Lat 46° 52'

Long 64° 21'

Wednesday 12th

Wind shifted into the S.W. and fresh at this day vessel steering S.W. at about 3 hours in the mid part tacked and stood into the S.W. and then tacked back nothing of note this day

Lat 47° 58'

Long 67° 01'

Thursday 13th

Wind moderated and hauled into the S.W. broke out broad & water and took the Bow Boat in deck. Mid part breezing and hauling into the S.W. and continued so the remainder of the day

Lat 49° 45'

Long 68° 57'

Friday 14th

Had backing breezes from S.W. S.W. course S.W. by W. nothing of note occurred this day

Lat 51° 06'

Long 65° 50'
