

At Talcahuano

Tuesday Apr 9th 1878.

Had good weather broke out the oil on Star side in Main Hatch and stowed the ground watch came and went as usual nothing more of note

Wednesday 10th

Had fine weather broke out the ground tier on Port side and stowed back also commenced stowing and filling ground in Fore hold with salt water watch came and went as usual

Thursday 11th

Had thick drizzly weather and wind from the S. put the remainder of our oil 6,249 sixty two hundred and forty nine gallons on board the Norwegian Bark Salen and stowed the ground tier on Port side in Fore hold and filled with salt water sunset sent the watch ashore as usual

Friday 12th

Commenced with good weather and moderate breezes from the S. daylight the watch came off stowed & filled the ground tier on Star side in Fore hold and took about 100 bbls of fresh water sunset sent the watch ashore and let go second anchor weather thick and wind backing from the S and Barometer falling

Saturday 13th

Moderated day light watch came off took up second anchor employed setting up clock sunset watch went ashore as usual

At Talcahuano.

Sunday Apr 14th 1878

Had fine weather daylight the watch came off John Costa a seaman missing sent the Star watch ashore on Liberty.

Monday 15th

Good weather the watch came off Antone Toracca and Paulino da Silva missing about 10 A.M. commenced heaving from the S. let go second anchor about 4 P.M. moderated wind shifted into the S.W. took up second anchor and sent the watch ashore

Tuesday 16th

Had fine weather the greater part of the day watch came off Fred Thomas missing employed the day setting up clock sunset sent the watch ashore as usual

Wednesday 17th

Day break watch came off Oried the sails got off some off our recruits & water and painted seams sunset sent the watch in as usual

Thursday 18th

Commenced with moderate breezes from the S. daylight the watch came off stowed off the Fore Peak and commenced painting some of the iron work Cooper employed setting up clock 3 P.M. blowing and raining from the S. sunset wind let go sent the watch in as usual sold 10 bbls of Pork
