Had Moderate Trade from the
S. E. repaired the lower main
top sail and began on the
upper fore top sail nothing more
of note this day

Thursday 20th
Had Strong Trade, finished
repairing the fore top sail
and put it up on the back
main top sail nothing since leaving
Calcuttano as usual

Friday 21st
Had Strong Trade employed this
day at work on the bands on
lower top sail yards

Lat-19° 40'
Long-91° 50'

Saturday 22nd
Had Strong Trade well to E
with frequent squalls of rain
employed shortening the main
brace yards also broke out
meat and water.
