Strong Trades vessel heading
the greater part of the
day employed making sight
saw nothing Lat-20°31'
Lon —

Wednesday 26th
Had Strong Trades and
squally vessel steering by
the wind employed making
sight so end Lat-22°22'
Lon-91°46'

Thursday June 27th 1878
Had Fresh Trades vessel steering
by the wind employed making
sight nothing more of note
Lat-24°07'
Lon-92°46'

Friday 28th
Had Strong Trades and squally
vessel steering into the SSE
by the wind nothing of note
occurred Lat-25°21'
Lon-93°18'

Saturday 29th
Had Strong Trades and squally
vessel steering into the S close
hailed nothing more of note
Lat-26°40'
Lon-93°42'

Sunday 30th
Had Fresh Trades and frequent
squalls vessel steering into the
S saw Finbacks Lat-28°02'
Lon-93°57'
