

Off Massapequa

Friday July 19th 1878.
Had light breeze from the S. & the greater part of this day employed making spinnaker and painting on work, saw several Finbacks and a Grampus
Lat-32°42'
Lon 81°18'

Saturday 20th
Wind hauled into the NW run in and sighted the Island saw several Finbacks nothing more of note
Lat-33°22'
Lon 80°59'

Sunday 21st
Had Clear weather and fresh breeze from the West saw several Finbacks
Lat 32°40'
Lon 80°59'

Monday 22nd
Commenced with fresh breeze from the Westward mid part calm and foggy latter part got a breeze from the N. broke out water & provisions. saw several Finbacks
Lat-32°30'

Tuesday 23rd
Wind hauled back into the Westward again and commenced breezing and blowing strong in squalls saw nothing
No Ob.

Off Massapequa

Wednesday July 24th 1878
Moderated and wind hauled into the S saw Finbacks and sail
Lat-31°53'
Lon 81°40'

Thursday 25th
Had Light breeze from the S all the first part. Mid part wind hauled into the Westward latter part wind shifted into the S.E. and beautiful weather employed cutting the upper main of sail saw several Finbacks
Lat-31°57'
Lon-82°06'

Friday 26th
Had Moderate breeze the wind hauled into the Westward again and continued so the greater part of this day with frequent squalls of fog & rain nothing of note occurred
Lat-32°48'
Lon 82°32'

Saturday 27th
Had light breeze from the W with frequent squalls of rain saw Finbacks nothing more of note
Lat-32°48'
Lon 82°23'

Sunday 28th
Had light West winds with frequent squalls wind stirring into the S. & W nothing more of note
Lat-32°53'
Lon 82°53'
