

## Cruising

Tuesday Feb 11<sup>th</sup> 1879.  
With Moderate breezes from the S.W. and thick hatter part clear and calm saw Black Fish.

Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup>  
Began with Calms and light airs from the S.W. Latter part calm employed putting new rope on the Sigsbee and caught a Blackfish also spoke the Jacob Howland & Stamboul.

Thursday 13<sup>th</sup>  
Began with light airs from the S. and part rainy latter part breezed up from the S. boiled the Black Fish and killed the Pig nothing more of note.

Friday 14<sup>th</sup>  
With Calms and light airs from the S. with rain latter part wind shifted into the S. saw Humpbacks. the Steward got a little high toned and had to take him down a little nothing more of note.

Saturday 15<sup>th</sup>  
Blowing from the S. the Island bearing about S by E. 15 miles latter part moderated some saw plenty Humpbacks nothing more of note.

## Cruising

Sunday Feb 16<sup>th</sup> 1879.  
Fresh breezes from the S. saw Black Fish nothing more of note.

Monday 17<sup>th</sup>  
Began with Moderate breezes from the S. and continued as throughout the day the Island bearing E by S 8 or 10 miles distant. broke out stars.

Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup>  
With Moderate breezes from the S. latter part caught a Swordfish the Island bearing E by S 15 miles distant.

Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup>  
Wind hauled into the N. spoke the Jane Martin. latter part blowing and rainy latter part wind shifted into the S. and clear nothing more of note.

Thursday 20<sup>th</sup>  
With Strong breezes from the S. and wind hauled to West and died out calm latter part got a breeze from the Westward the Island in sight to leeward.

Friday 21<sup>st</sup>  
With Fresh baffling breezes from the Westward with squalls of rain latter part with light airs from same quarter caught two Black Fish nothing more of note.
