Thursday Apr 24th 1879
With moderate breezes from
the Eastward. Latter part
Calum painted the boats
broke out - slops & set up
the Bob Stays

Friday 25th
With light - airs from the West.
Massafuera in sight - to windward
nothing of note occurred

Saturday 26th
With moderate breezes from the
West - Mid part - wind hauled
into the S.E. and breezing

Sunday 27th
With strong breezes from the
Eastward passed the Island
and steered off N.W. nothing
more of note

Monday 28th
With strong breezes from
the S.E. saw a Whaler to windward
steering down

Tuesday 29th
With strong breezes from the S.E.
saw two sail nothing more of
note

Wednesday 30th
With fresh breezes from the
S.E. spoke the Sautelle just
taking a hundred barrels
of Spum

Cruising

Thursday May 1st 1879
Moderated some take out -
Water nothing more of note
Lat - 33° 38'
Lon 83° 35'

Friday 2nd
With light - breezes from the
S.E. took up the oil cloth
in the forward cabin and
caulked & pitched the floor.
nothing more of note

Saturday 3rd
Light - airs from the S.E. with
frequent - squalls. Massafuera
bearing about S by E 8 miles
distant saw one sail

Sunday 4th
With light - breezes from the
S.E. nothing of note occurred
Lat - 33° 57'
Lon 81° 30'

Monday 5th
Calum employed overhauling
the Windlass nothing more
of note

Tuesday 6th
With Calum & light - airs from the
S. Chatter part raised a Log spm
Whale and covered the Blacksmith
shop set up and fire going
shipkeepers at work on the
Windlass
