

Cruising

Friday May 30th 1879
With clear weather and moderate breeze from the Westward spoke the bark of Stamboul Island bearing 20 miles distant

Saturday 31st
With fine weather and moderate breeze from the West - went in fishing and done well

Sunday June 1st 1879
Began with good weather and moderate breeze from the West vessel steering into the bay to under all sail latter part - thick fog

Monday 2nd
Wind shifted into the S and breeze from the latter part with strong breeze saw the Sautelur nothing more of note

Tuesday 3rd
Strong breeze from the S & with frequent squalls of rain the Island in sight - to windward

Wednesday 4th
Strong S & W winds third & latter part - moderate with frequent rain squalls spoke the Sautelur

Cruising

Thursday June 5th 1879
Fresh falling breeze from the S & W. latter part with light air from same quarter the Island in sight to Eastward

Friday 6th
Began with light air and calm latter part - moderate breeze the Island bearing about S.W. 45 miles

Saturday 7th
Good breeze from the East vessel steering to the greater part of the day saw Sautelur

Sunday 8th
With moderate breezes from the S & W with frequent fog squalls latter part with light air from the S. saw large quantities of Sautelur and a sail
Lat - 33° 00'
Lon 80° 08'

Monday 9th
With moderate breezes from the S latter part - wind hauled into the Westward saw a sail nothing more broke out - Water

Tuesday 10th
With light breezes from the West - saw large quantities of Sautelur
Lat - 32° 45'
Lon 82° 32'
