Thursday July 24th 79

rain squalls run down
about 80 lbs of oil so ends

Tuesday 29th
Good weather employed
storing oil and fluting
spokes boards & shanks
Mr. Senior a seaman
had a finger broken
and hand badly smashed
nothing more of note

Cruising
Wednesday July 30th 79
Fine weather finished storing
down and washed the
board work saw three
Whalers to leeward
Lat 32° 40'
Lon 83° 55'

Thursday 31st
Freezing from the N.E. W.
latter part wind got
around into the S. vessel
steering into the Eastward
Lat 32° 15'
Lon 83° 15'

Friday August 1st 79
Moderate breeze from N.E. W.
latter part also saw
the Sapolon gun thence
to windward

Saturday 2nd
With light air from the
S. nothing of note occurred
this day Lat 32° 45'
Lon 83° 50'

Sunday 3rd
Wind caught back into
the N.E. W. latter part
sailed into the S. again
strong breeze and equally

Monday 4th
Begins with strong S. winds
latter part moderate wind
headed into the S. spoke
the Sapolon Lat 32° 25'
Lon 83° 00'
