

Cruising

Tuesday Aug 8th 1879
Moderate employed towing
ground tier in fore part
nothing more of note

Wednesday 9th
Wind parted into two
S. and S. by E. spoke the
Stamboul and saw several
other sail Lat-32°35'
Lon 84°10'

Thursday 10th
From fore part the S.
employed pulling up
Stamboul nothing more
of note

Friday 11th
With strong breeze from
the S. latter part blowing
a calm Lat-32°28'
Lon 84°19'

Saturday 12th
Wind moderated from and
hauling into the Westward
latter part employed breaking
up Stamboul in fore part
about 9 A.M. raised
a sperm whale and lured
that boat went on and
struck Bow Stamboul. Boat
chased off and Bow boat
got another saw the
Stamboul astern whaling
so ends Lat-33°30'
Lon 83°50'

Cruising

Sunday Aug 10th 79
Fine weather got the whale
to the vessel and got dinner
at 4 P.M. saw the Bear aloft
and holes cut. Spent night
stayed on got his head
off and body in saw
the Stamboul cutting.

Monday 11th
Light air from the S
got his head in and
latter part and set
the watches daylight
looked on to the second
eye and got his head
in body in. Four whales
in sight

Tuesday 12th
Moderate got his case
overboard at sunset and
set the watches and checked
the work Lat-32°05'
Lon 83°21'

Wednesday 13th
Moderate breeze from the
Westward employed pulling
Lat-32°15'
Lon 83°17'

Thursday 14th
Fresh breeze from the Westward
employed pulling also. Littered
the ground tier fore part
on Port side saw two sail
to windward Lat-32°31'
Lon 82°16'
