Friday Aug 15th 1879

Good weather and moderate breeze from the Westward finished stowing the ground tier in fore peak and filled it with oil

Saturday 16th
Moderate finished stowing down and washed the vessel and nothing to note

Sunday 17th
Moderate breeze from the East and the Canadian 1/2 paid station

Monday 18th
Boring wind caused to Westward and thick weather from all shores

Tuesday 19th
Strong breeze from the West with rain latter part and rain set up the fore and some several gobs of blacksmithing

Wednesday 20th
Boring employed at repairing the anchor spoke the anchor and nothing more of note

Cruising

Thursday Aug 21st 1879

Blowing strong from the West repaired the Mizzen stay sail
Lat - 32° 54'
Lon 83° 43'

Friday 22nd
Strong breeze from the West latter part moderate repaired the lower main top sail

Saturday 23rd
Moderate repaired the lower fore top sail nothing more of note

Sunday 24th
Wind hauled into the S.W. latter part calm gale in St. Michael
Lat - 32° 40'
Lon 83° 19'

Monday 25th
Begins with light airs from the S.W. latter part strong breeze repaired the fore sail

Tuesday 26th
Blowing from the S.W. & W. nothing more of note occurred

Wednesday 27th
Moderate some repaired the lower main top sail & so nothing more of note
Lat - 32° 39'
Lon 83° 16'
