

Cruising

Thursday Aug 28<sup>th</sup> 1879.  
Cruising from the westward  
with fresh breeze from the  
S.W. with occasional rain  
water part - blowing strong

Friday 29<sup>th</sup>  
Blowing strong from the  
S.W. repaired the vessel  
and went out - saw nothing  
Lat - 32° 55'  
Lon 72° 44'

Saturday 30<sup>th</sup>  
Strong S.W. winds and  
clear weather water  
part - moderate with  
frequent squalls. Rain  
repaired the - the vessel  
steering S.W. Lat 33° 22'  
Lon 75° 17'

Sunday 31<sup>st</sup>  
Fresh breeze from the  
vessel steering E by N passed  
Massachusetts nothing of  
note occurred this day  
Lat - 33° 42'  
Lon 80° 59'

Monday Sept 1<sup>st</sup> 1879  
Fresh breeze from the N.W. the  
vessel steering E by N  
broke out - sighted 4 or 5  
in sight - ahead

Tuesday Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> 1879.  
With fresh breeze from the  
S.W. with occasional rain  
vessel laying off from at  
noon

Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup>  
Wind shifted into the  
S.W. about 9 o'clock  
nothing more of note  
this day

Thursday 4<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate wind hauled  
into the N. got 7 or 8  
wood and light - S.W. &  
saw the Bark Stambord  
getting wood also sold  
about 50 ft of flat boards

Friday 5<sup>th</sup>  
Moderate breeze from the N.W.  
the mid part - squally wind hauled  
into the S.W. vessel steering S.W.  
water part - strong breeze from  
the S.W. vessel steering into  
the Eastward Lat 34° 00'  
Lon 77° 42'

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup>  
With strong breeze from the  
S.W. vessel steering into the  
S.W. part - tacked into the E  
water part - tacked back into  
the S again Lat 34° 38'  
Lon 78° 33'

Sunday 7<sup>th</sup>  
Strong S.W. wind vessel working  
to windward nothing of note  
occurred Lat 34° 47'  
Lon 78° 18'
