

## Cruising

Monday Sept 8<sup>th</sup> 1879  
With fresh S.W. wind. At 10<sup>00</sup>  
wind hauled into the  
S.W. & tacked and steered  
S.E. by E. the remainder  
of the day scraped the  
bottom and pushed down

Lat - 35° 28'  
Lon 76° 28'

## Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup>

With fresh breeze from  
the S.W. wind shifted  
and went up to the  
latter part the wind hauled  
into the S.E. & stood into  
the Eastward again

Lat 36° 28'  
Lon 74° 58'

## Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup>

With strong breeze from  
the S.E. & wind stirring  
at 10<sup>00</sup> tacked into  
the S.W. latter part stood  
in shore again

Lat - 36° 36'  
Lon 73° 47'

## Thursday 11<sup>th</sup>

With strong breeze from the  
S.E. & went to the made  
the land and tacked off  
under short sail latter  
part - moderate - stood in  
S.E. - the cables bent and  
nothing more of note

## At Calcuttano.

Friday Sept 12<sup>th</sup> 79.  
With light S.W. from the S  
stood into the Bay about  
sunset then wind let go  
clewed up the sails and  
towed in to an anchorage  
latter part light air from the Eastward  
got under way and worked up into  
the harbor washed ship out side and  
put the purchase tackle aloft

## Saturday 13<sup>th</sup>

Clear weather broke out the after hold  
sunset - put - put - the watch ashore  
took a boat load of water also  
furnished the after cabin

## Sunday 14<sup>th</sup>

Light air from the S & Port  
watch ashore on duty  
nothing more of note

## Monday 15<sup>th</sup>

Good weather day long the watch  
came to employed taking water  
and flowing back in hold  
watch went out and came as  
usual

## Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup>

Good weather took our recruits  
on board also sold two pieces  
of drillings and (679) six hundred  
and seventy nine gallons of sperm oil

## Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup>

Took a boat-load of water and finished  
the work in hold and washed off  
watch went & came as usual
