of the day got the Whale
in and head cleared
away and set the watcher
off.

Thursday 4th
Blowing a Gale from the
westward wind lighter and
under lower 10th sail and from
star side employed cutting
blubber saw the same whale
and killed to seaward.

Friday 5th
Moderated and noted the
works nothing more
of note.

Saturday 6th
Cabin finished forling
and washed off oil
stairing looks nothing
more of note.

Cruising

Sunday Dec 7th 79.
With thick weather and
fresh breeze from the N.E. 10th
saw the same Right Whale
a Whale.

Lat - 46-25
Lon 82-30

Monday 8th
With fresh breezes from the N.
stowed down 10th oil and
spiced about 50 lbs of fresh water
and down in the oil tank also
saw a Right Whale going
to windward covered and
chased several times nothing
more of note.

Tuesday 9th
With fresh breezes from the
westward and thick weather
washed the paint-work
and chased a Right Whale
also spoke the Thellon.

Wednesday 10th
Blowing a Gale from the N.E. 10th
nothing more of note.

Thursday 11th
Moderated and employed
scrapping down nothing more
of note.

Friday 12th
Blowing a Gale from the N. with
frequent squalls of hail saw a
Whaler to windward.
