Saturday Dec 12th 1879
Blowing a Gale from the West
saw two White Whales from
dark nothing more of note

Sunday 13th

Blowing a Gale wind hauled
into the S vessel staying easy
Lat - 46-35
Lon 82-18

Monday 13th

Moderate, made some sail
wind backing from the
S to the S.W. explored
splitting & spralling boat
weather thick and rainy
so ended

Tuesday 15th

Blowing from the Westward
rather part blowing a Gale
Lat - 46-46
Lon 82-30

Wednesday 17th

Blowing a Gale from the
Westward nothing of note
saw

Thursday 18th

Moderate, made full sail
again rather part wind
hauled into the North
caught a Porpoise

Friday 19th

Moderate with rain and light
sailing from S to E and S
vessel staying S.W. nothing
more of note

Cruising

Saturday Dec 20th 1879
With fresh breezes and frequent
squalls from the Westward
vessel steering into the S.W.
saw nothing Lat - 40-24
Lon 84-10

Sunday 21st

With strong breeze from
the Westward with frequent
squalls saw the ship
to the S.W. Lat - 46-15
Lon 84-14

Monday 22nd

With strong breeze from the W
with fog rather part clear
saw the S.W. El nothing
more of note

Tuesday 23rd

With fresh breezes from the
Westward vessel steering N.E.
saw a sail and caught a
porpoise Lat - 40-25
Lon 81-30

Wednesday 24th

With fresh breezes from the
S.W. and thick weather vessel
steering S.E. by E caught a porpoise
Lat - 45-57
Lon 79-04

Thursday 25th

Moderate breezes from the W
vessel steering S.E. by E rather
part wind hauled into the
N and rainy Lat - 45-37
Lon 78-01
