 part of the day saw
 several sail.

Wednesday 19th

Thursday 20th

Friday 21st
 Blowing strong from the N. W.
 broke out broad & West
 saw several whales nothing
 more of note.

Saturday 22nd
 Moderate wind hauled into
 the N. W. with frequent
 fog squalls spoke the
 Sautiles and Cancer
 nothing more of note.

Sunday 23rd
 Moderate breeze from the
 North and fine weather
 stood close in to the Island
 and then stored N. W. & E.
 saw Humpbacks nothing
 more of note.

Monday 24th
 With thick weather and moderate
 breeze from the Westward caught
 a Gladfish.
