

Off Knap

Monday Jan 27th 1880
With fresh breeze from the
N. repaired the fore stay
hull.

Tuesday Jan 28th
With moderate breeze from
the West with clear weather
repaired main sail fore
gall sail & storm sparker.

Wednesday Jan 29th
With moderate winds and
bubbling down several
small jobs about the vessel.

Thursday Jan 30th
Blowing wind changing gradually
into the N. latter part
blowing a Gale and raining.

Friday Jan 31st
Wind shifted into the North
and blowed heavy all the
day vessel trying on port tack.
Lat 43° 41'
Long 76° 35'

Saturday Feb 1st 1880
Moderate the wind changing
gradual into the N. & E. & E.
sighted in and sighted
the Island.

Sunday Feb 2nd
With strong breeze from the
Westward the Island in
sight to forward.

Cruising

Tuesday Jan 27th 1880
With strong breeze from the
Westward and frequent squalls.

Wednesday Jan 28th
Blowing strong from the N. W.
vessel steering to E. & the
greater part of this day.

Thursday Jan 29th
Breeze with moderate breeze
from the N. W. latter half
wind backed into the
S. W. with rain.
Lat 41° 21'

Friday Jan 30th
With strong breeze from the
Westward and thick weather
vessel steering into the
S. W. saw several Guineas.

Saturday Jan 31st
With moderate breeze
from the N. W. and light
vessel steering into the
S. E. saw four whales.

Sunday Feb 1st 1880
Moderate breeze in sight
about 30 miles distant. Spoke
the Bark Gophers & S. A. Broude
nothing more of note.

Monday Feb 2nd
With fresh breeze from the
Westward and thick weather
spoke the Cantelus.
