Wednesday Feb 22 1880
Wind hauled into the
land blowing with rain

at Suva
Thursday Feb 23 1880
Blowing a fair breeze from the
westward saw the
B.S. Howland and Nautilus
to leeward

Friday Feb 24 1880
Moderated evening wind
hauled into the 8th
vessel steering into the
8 spoke the Nautilus
B.S. Howland and Standard
all bound southward

Blowing strong from the
westward with frequent
squalls vessel steering
into the 8th in company
with the Nautilus

Lat - 43-09
Long 76-14

at Suva
Sunday Feb 26 1880
Blowing from the 8th
vessel steering into the
8 under all sail latter
part blowing strong with
rain broke out water and
Sugar. Nautilus in sight
also saw a Porpoise
steering into the land

Cruising

at Suva
Monday Feb 27 1880
With moderate breeze blowing
from the 8th to 8th vessel
steering into the 8th the
greater part of this day

Lat - 41-04
Long 75-38

at Suva
Tuesday Feb 28 1880
Breeze with fresh breeze
from the 8th with rain
vessel steering into the 8th
latter part wind hauled
into the 8th vessel steering into
the Nautilus in sight to
leeward

at Suva
Wednesday Feb 29 1880
With fresh breeze from the
8th vessel steering 8th to 8th
at work in the rigging smart-
ened too on the foremast
tick main yard aback so ends

Lat - 38-43
Long 76-40

at Suva
Thursday Feb 30 1880
With fresh breeze from the
8th and clear weather vessel
steering 8th to 8th the greater
part of the day: spliced the
main top mast sprit stay and
done several other jobs in the
rigging

Lat - 37-33
Long 77-40
