

Cruising

Monday Feb 12th 1880
With moderate breeze from
the N and clear weather
repaired the main top
sail, vessel steering N 80° E &
the greater part of the
day Lat 36-58.
Long 78-40.

Tuesday 13th
With good weather and moderate
breeze from the N by N we
steamed and saw the Gambel
Santitas and Galapagos

Wednesday 14th
With strong breeze from the N
and under full sail steering
into the N 80° E saw several
Santitas and two whales
after light found strong stowed
down from the main
Lat 36-55
Long 78-20

Thursday 15th
Running a moderate breeze
from the N 80° E about rain
set in the fore top sail and
under the N 80° E in company
with the Santitas. passed the
Lancers Laine too almost stowed
the fore top sail and went to
on the Port tack Lat 37-57
Long 76-30

Friday Feb 16th 1880
With strong breeze from the
N 80° E daylight kept the N 80° E
and about same time
raised sperm whales close
alongside luffed too and
set our engine for the Santitas
who was close to windward
and lowered. Last boat went
on a missed Santitas waist boat
went on soon after and got
our way on board and
helped cut took the bow in
and got the head marked on
our side and holes cut -
the lashed down for the
night the wind moderating
and heavy sea running so side

Saturday 17th
Moderate breeze from the N
and got it in started the
boats so early.

Sunday 18th
Again the weather kept - N.
This day finished boiling
Juan Fernandez in sight to
the westward

Monday 19th
With moderate breeze from the N
about 6 A.M. raised sperm whales
off our bow going quick to windward
set signals for the Santitas to windward
and lowered. whale came to windward
of us and the last boat struck one
got him alongside at 12:30 and
hooked on gave the Santitas the word
got the body in and lashed down at sunset
Juan in sight.
