

Off Juan Fernandez

Thursday Apr 8th 1880
With fresh breeze from the
south vessel standing N. & W.
from daylight until dark
Juan in sight off her bow

at 10⁰⁰ AM
With fresh S.W. winds and thick
weather stopping under
the lee of the island and
anchored about 10 miles
S. of the island the boat
went on to windward
again nothing more of note

at 10⁰⁰ AM
With strong breeze from the S.W.
vessel standing into the S.W. Juan
Fernandez in sight to leeward
nothing more of note

at 10⁰⁰ AM
With strong breeze from the
S.W. and thick weather
passed Thasafuera and steered
N.W. sunset the island bearing
S.W. 10⁰⁰ miles

at 10⁰⁰ AM
With strong breeze from the
S.W. and thick weather
thick weather spoke the 7th
Came Martin & Sautilus

at 10⁰⁰ AM
With fresh breeze from the
S.W. vessel standing N.W.
& came Martin to forward
put new down hauls & sheets
forward also made a new
set of boat-grips all around

Off Thasafuera

Wednesday Apr 15th 1880
With fresh breeze from the
S.W. employed repairing lower
fore top sail this eve spoke
the Sautilus

at 10⁰⁰ AM
With light breeze from the
Eastward finished repairing
the fore top sail and sent
it spoke the Capt. Howland
Came Martin & Sautilus

at 10⁰⁰ AM
With breeze and light air
from the Westward took
out water and done several
other small jobs. Island
in sight to leeward

at 10⁰⁰ AM
Wind drifted into the N.W.
blowing fresh and thick
weather nothing of note
observed

at 10⁰⁰ AM
Thunder wind drifted into
the S.W. saw a Sautilus
nothing more of note

at 10⁰⁰ AM
With light air and calm
finished all fore boats
nothing more of note

at 10⁰⁰ AM
With light breeze from the S.
put new foot & head ropes
on the lower main top sail
nothing more of note
