

Cruising

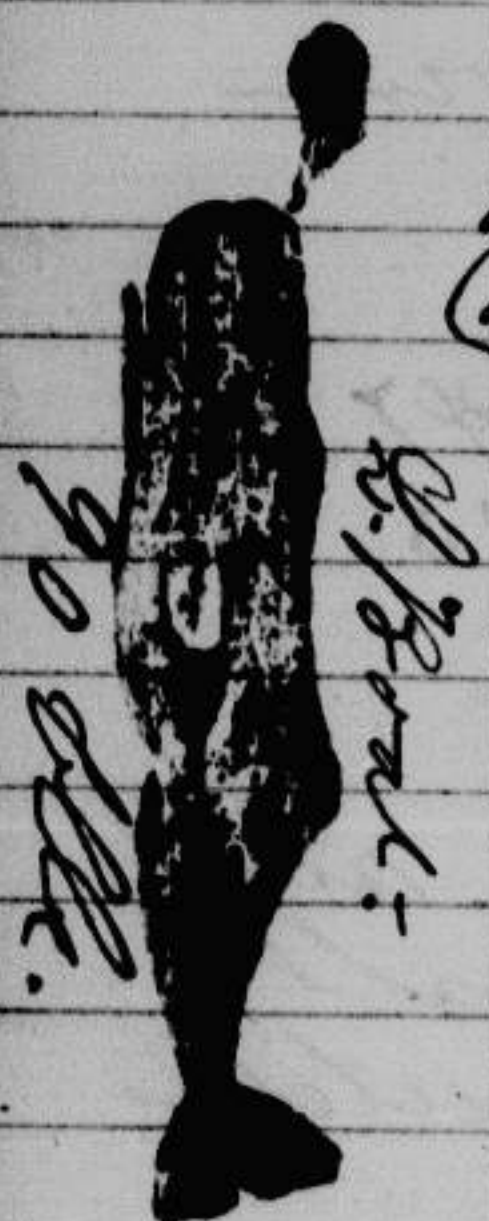
Wednesday June 29th 1880
Wind hauled into the S.W. and blowing strong and thick saw the *Lucretia* to leeward whaling also saw a sperm whale just at night going quick to windward.

Thursday 30th
With strong breeze from the Westward and thick saw nothing of note.

Friday July 1st 1880
Moderated and wind hauled into the S. saw several Finbacks, *Santilus* and *Lucretia* nothing more of note.

Saturday 2nd
Moderate breeze from the S. and smoky saw several Finbacks employed the day picking over *Polatos* nothing more of note.

Sunday 3rd
With fresh breeze from the S.W. and smoky about 8 AM raised sperm whales going quick to leeward lowered the three Lab Houts and chased third rising the Lab Boat struck at him alongside and marked the head on one side and cut holes and took the jaw: the *Santilus* chased off.



Cruising

Monday July 4th 1880
With fine weather began at day break and celebrated all day sunset got the *Lucy* overboard and at the watches the *Charger* & *Lucretia* in sight to leeward gamming.

Tuesday 5th
Began with fresh breeze from the S.W. latter part wind increased to a Gale and raining cooled down and made all secure.

Wednesday 6th
Wind shifted into the S.W. and moderated some started the fire again. saw a Merchant-Boat steering into the S.W.

Thursday 7th
With strong breeze from the S.W. vessel heading into the Westward latter part blowing from the North and threatening rain the Head oil and finished boiling.

Friday 8th
Blowing a Gale from the S. and raining stowed the Fore Top sail and made all secure latter part wind hauled into the Westward and blowing yet.

Saturday 9th
Moderated wind hauled back into the S. finished stowing down and washed the *Lucy* down hot 30-50 now 81-80.
