Saturday 23rd

part wind hauled into
the Westward and chased
off saw two sail

Sunday 24th
With High-airs and Calms
spoke the game Martin
Lat-43-19
Long 77-33

Monday 25th
With strong breezes from
the Westward vessel
steering E. saw two
Merchandise.
Lat-43-42
Long 77-50

Tuesday Oct-26th 1880
Wind from the E. latter part
with rain wind hauled back
into the Westward

Wednesday 27th
With strong West-winds and
squally saw the game Martin
to theward

Thursday 28th
Calms set up the day and
for spoke shrouds and done
several other jobs about
the vessel. this evening spoke
game Martin to end

Friday 29th
With fresh breezes from the
E.W. and thick weather nothing
of note occurred

Saturday 30th
With strong breezes from the E.W.
vessel steering E. all the first-
part latter part stood into
the E.W. saw High-Whales and
chased (not a horse price)

Sunday 31st
Blowing strong from the
E.W. and rugged saw Martin
in sight to theward nothing
more of note.
