

Off Huaffo.

Wednesday Dec 14th 1880
Moderate saw several
Humpbacks and Finbacks
employed making circuit
nothing more of note

Thursday 15th
With strong West winds
and thick weather nothing
of note occurred.

Friday 16th
Blowing a Gale from the
S.W. saw the 13th Galleon
to seaward

Saturday 17th
Moderated before the
Galleon nothing more
of note.

Sunday 18th
With light baffling winds
from all points of the
compass took out water

Monday 19th
Moderate breeze from the
S.W. saw the Galleon
take a sperm whale the
school started off into
the S quick run chased
off until dark and then
shortened sail did not
lower the Island of Chiloe
in sight to seaward

Off Huaffo

Tuesday Dec 20th 1880
Blowing strong from the Westward
vessel heading into the South
all day sunset the Island
bearing E 20 miles. caught 5 porpoises
nothing more of note

Wednesday 21st
With strong breeze from the
S.W. North frequent squalls
saw the Island bearing E 20 miles
distant

Thursday 22nd
Moderate employed rail mending
9 or also chased a Humpback
to ends

Friday 23rd
With high air from the N
and clear fresh steering
S.W. washed the Bone

Saturday 24th
With moderate breeze from the
W. rather part-wind trilled
into the S vessel working
into the S employed drying
Bone and scraping spars

Sunday 25th
With light S.W. winds and good
weather spoke the Island
and steered S.W. all day
Lat 41.49
Long 73.73
