and clear employed breaking
out also run down the
lead on. Lat 42-56
Lon 76-00

Tuesday 27th
With light fair from
the North the greater
part of the day and clear
weather finished stowing
down and got decks clear
12.30 raised a line span
whale and waist boat
got him got him alongside
hired raised holes cut and
lead marked and took
the gun

Wednesday 28th
Blowing strong from the N
and raining finished
cutting and started the
works

Thursday Feb 29th 1881
Blowing strong from the S.W.
the greater part of this
day with frequent squalls
a rain employed boiling
Lat 43-06
Lon 76-00

Friday 30th
With fresh breeze from the
S employed boiling nothing
of note occurred
Lat 43-07
Lon 77-01

Saturday 31st
With thick weather wind
hauled into the S again
latter part rainy employed
boiling
Sunday 1st
Wind shifted into the S
and down the head oil
latter part wind hauled
gradually into the West

Monday 2nd
With moderate breeze from
the Westward finished
stowing down and washed
the paint-work vessel steering
O. G. C. E. all day saw a
whaler.
