

Passage from the

Wednesday June 18th 1881
Got a breeze from the
S.W. and entered S.C.W.
about 3 P.M. made the
land east-end of Long Island
and cleared S.W. for
the mouth of the Sound
the weather clear and
wind light and well to
westward.

Thursday, 19th
Light S.W. winds about
9-30 A.M. took Pilot off Quibblebunk
and about 1 P.M. cast our anchor
in New Bedford harbor after
a very pleasant voyage of 45 hours
1 day.
