Sunday August 19th 1881
These 24 hours light airs and calm between St George and Lucia plenty of Grampoids in sight -
So ends these 24 hours

Monday 20th
The first part calm middle and latter part calm light
airs from the SW latter part to the N 3 and in
sight - so ends

Tuesday 21st
These 24 hours light airs and calm land for hills
with out success so ends

Wednesday 22nd
These 24 hours light airs and calm 5th sail seen
so ends

Thursday 23rd
The first part light airs from the South at 11 AM
latter part strong breezes from the SW heading to the
W N W 5th sail in sight so ends

Friday 24th
The first part strong breezes heading to the W N W
middle and latter part moderate heading to the SSE
saw a ship cutting so ends

Saturday 25th
The first part light airs middle part calm latter part
light airs from the South at 11 AM spoke bark
Spanian Provincetown 60 miles Tugal bearing South
dist 45 miles 3 sail in sight so ends

Sunday 26th
The first part light airs from the SW heading to the
W N W middle part short sail latter part light breezes
and fine weather at 9 AM saw sperm whales landed
8 boats galled one missed a netter got more saw
a bark like a whale along side so ends
Hond of Fregal heading SE by E dist 30 miles

Cruising in the North Atlantic

Monday Sept 10th 1881
The first part strong breezes and squally from the
at 1 PM went on shore at 6 PM came off middle
laying off and latter part landed one but got no more off
so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday Sept 11th
The first part strong breezes at the same as at 1 PM
at 1 PM went on shore at 6 PM came off middle
laying off and latter part landed one but got no more off
so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday Sept 12th
The first part from middle spoke bark Hove latter part
strong breezes from the SSE and squally setting off
so ends

Thursday Sept 13th
The first part strong breezes from the South middle
part heavy thunder and light rain latter part
squally so ends

Friday Sept 14th
The first part strong breezes from the SW latter
part moderate breezes from the SW at 11 AM
2 sail in sight so ends

Saturday Sept 15th
The first part at 11 AM middle lay to latter part
wind SE heading SE so ends

Sunday Sept 16th
The first part moderate at 11 AM took a breeze
from the SW middle short sail latter part
strong breezes at 12 noon bore N W dist 15 miles

Monday Sept 17th
These 24 hours strong breezes and squally middle part
bore to latter part at 12 noon bore N W dist 15 miles
2 sail seen so ends

Tuesday Sept 18th
The first part blowing fresh and squally middle
and latter part the same bore to so ends

Wednesday Sept 19th
These 24 hours strong breezes and squally middle part
bore to latter part at 12 noon bore N W dist 15 miles
2 sail seen so ends
