70 30.15 employed fitting 3 white ropes same as said

73 30.10 the H N.W. spoke ship Hunter. Flatt
74 30.05-62 day out 54 hls middle part calm latter part
wind N.E heading N.W. saw a French
brig so ends

76 27.80 The first part thick and rainy with thunder
77 27.80 middle and latter calm and foggy nothing
78 27.88 seen so ends

Monday Jan 5th

76 27.82 These 24 hours light air all round
77 27.84 compass extra part H N.W. nothing
78 27.84 seen so ends
Sat 33.40 Long 47.40

Tuesday Jan 6th

76 28.85 The first part moderate breezes from the H
77 29.96 heading to the S and E middle part heading
78 27.75 S.E. latter part blowing a gale from the H
none to heading to the H and so ends
so ends

Wednesday Jan 7th

70 27.75 The first part blowing a moderate gale from
71 30. - the S.W. middle part moderate latter part
72 30. - calm 2 whale ships in sight so ends

Thursday Jan 8th

70 27.75 The first part calm at 3 PM light air from N.E
71 27.82 spoke Bart. Express N.B. 100 hls ship time out
72 27.87 sight 45 days out 40 hls had carried away 3 top
mast since he sailed, at 4 PM squalls of wind
and rain from the H ward at 7 clear heading
to the South blowing strong

Friday Jan 9th

72 27.85 The first part strong breezes from the H
73 27.90 middle and latter part the same heavy sea
74 27.95 nothing worthy of remarks so ends
Sat 35.48 Long 45.30

Saturday Jan 10th

66 30.15 The first part strong breezes heading to the
67 30.15 west ward latter part calm heavy swell
68 30.17 so ends
