Bark James Andrews Band on a Cruise

Tuesday March 23rd 1859

The first part finished getting recruits on board at 6 AM have shot at 7 got under way with a light air from the SW at 12 AM off Point Barre. 4 men shot

Wednesday 24th

The first part fine breeze from the SE at 12 PM lashed to the South light latter part the same state and one man sick

Thursday March 25th

These 24 hours moderate breezes from NE to ENE at 12 PM wind shifted to the SE same jumpers are sent the sick getting better

at last

Friday March 26th

The first part strong breezes sent down fore top gallant mast to put a new cap on the top mast head middle and latter part moderate employed fitting top gallant rigging

at last

Saturday March 27th

The first part light air from the NE at 7 PM wind shifted to the SE latter part light air from SE sent up fore top gallant mast etc

at last

Sunday March 28th

The first part light from the SE middle part the same latter part heading N moderate same jumpers

at last

Monday March 29th

The first part light air from ENE at 7 PM lashed to the SE latter part strong breezes from the ENE heading to the NE rain
