Thursday Apr 15/52
The first part light airs from the NNE and calm at 8 PM took the ladies heading N by E latter part heading N wind ENE so ends
Lat 13° 25' Long 31° 30'

Friday Apr 16
These 24 hours wind NE to East N by the wind to the N some light squalls had ladies so ends
Lat 13° 34' Long 32° 24'

Saturday April 17th
These 24 hours moderate breezes from NNE to E N by the wind employed tacking down rigging &c so ends
Lat 11° 34' Long 32° 28'

Sunday Apr 18th
These 24 hours wind E to E by S NNE same 2 sail light breezes so ends
Lat 10° 03' Long 31° 40'

Monday April 19
The first part S NNE at 6 PM S N by E at 11 PM sailing sail at 5 AM took them in latter part heading N by E so ends
Lat 7° 50' Long 32° 30' due

Tuesday April 20th
These 24 hours wind E to E by S N by the wind heading N by E to NNE by N employed on the rigging nothing seen so ends
Lat 5° 59' Long 32° 14'

Wednesday Apr 21st
The first part moderate heading N by S middle part S N by E at 3 PM S NNE at 6 PM N by E set steering sails at 8 AM the 1st land of Fernandezana heading N strong breezes and squally at 12 M it bore NNE dist 20 miles so ends
Lat 2° 35' Long 31° 03'

Thursday April 22nd
The first part light breezes at 4 PM the North end of the Island bore N Dist 10 miles S N by E found the chronometer to be 1.1 miles to Eward of ship middle light and squally latter part heading off NNE so ends
Lat 2° 35' Long 31° 03'

Friday Apr 23rd
The first part light airs from the N and calm middle and latter part the same

Saturday Apr 24
These 24 hours light airs from the N and calm heading N to NNE so ends
Lat 2° 17' Long 34° 24'

Sunday Apr 25th
These 24 hours wind varying from NNE to NNE and squally tacked ship as occasion required one sail seen so ends
NO Obs Lat 1° 56' Long 34° 01'

Monday April 26
These 24 hours winds variable and squally tacked as occasion required so ends
Lat 1° 34' Long 33° 31' the
Sun 32° 30'

Tuesday Apr 27
These 24 hours light airs from NNE to NNE S by the wind tacked as occasion required so ends
Lat 1° 24' Long 32° 58' the

Wednesday Apr 28
These 24 hours light wind and variable tacked as occasion required 4 sail in sight bound to the North 3 tacked and one ship so ends
Lat 01° 09' S Long 32° 45'

Thursday Apr 29
The first wind all round the compass squally from the S and E middle and latter part wind NNE to NNE 2 tacked one ship bound to the in sight one Steamboat bound to the South

Friday Apr 30
The first part strong breezes and squally from NNE to NNE S by the wind to the NNE 4 sail in sight at 11 PM tacked to the NNE and latter part heading NNE 2 tacked in sight so ends
Lat 01° 24' Long 32° 45'
