Sunday May 2nd

These 24 hours strong breezes from the N. S. E.
by the wind to the N.W. making very little
to North nothing seen so ends

Sat 2.21 Long 34.48

May 3rd

These 24 hours moderate breezes from N to N.E.
watch employed in ship duty ordered the job a job
mat to be set up and out pound in set so end
painted it had

Sat 3.09 Long 36.25

May 4th

These 24 hours strong breezes from the N.E. S.
by the wind to the N.W. put on preventer back
Stays on the top gallant masts so ends

Sat 4.41 Long 38.29

May 5th

These 24 hours strong breezes heading N.W. by N and N.W.
nothing worthy of remarks so ends

Sat 6.42 Long 40.32

May 6th

These 24 hours strong breezes parted fore top
gallant sheet single reefed the fore top sail
set top gallant sail over it N.W. so end

Sat 9.05 Long 42.33

May 7th

These 24 hours rather more moderate all sail
set N.W. nothing seen so ends

Sat 11.41 Long 44.09

May 8th

The first part strong breezes at 5th saw a school of
sperm whales came 2 boats struck 2 at 7 got one
along side at 10 got the other one along side and boats
up look in sail at 6 AM began to cut at 9 finished
made sail clearing a way have one in whale
so ends

Sat 12.28 Long 45.05

Sunday May 9th 1852

The first part clearing away the heads etc. at 4 PM
started fire at 4.30 finished bailing about 12.40
made all sail N.W. by N.W. and back in sight
N.W. by N so ends

Sat 14.17 Long 46.01

Monday May 10th

These 24 hours moderate breezes N.W. by N. Steaming sail
set nothing worthy of remarks so ends

Tuesday May 11th

The first part light breezes at 2 PM strong breezes
took in all sails heading N.W. middle and latter
part heading N.W. so ends

Wednesday May 12th

These 24 hours strong breezes N.W. by N and N. nothing
seen so ends

Sat 2.42 Long 49.00 Use
June 48.00 30.00

Thursday May 13th

These 24 hours fresh breezes from the E.N.E. S.
N.W. put 3 lashes of oil between decks saw an
sail N to the N.W. so ends

Sat 24.24 Long 49.49

Friday May 14th

The first part strong breezes N.W. by E at 4 PM saw
Sperm Whales looked for them the latter part N.W.
nothing seen so ends

Sat 27.16 Long 50.16

Saturday May 15th

The first part strong breezes N.W. by E at 3 PM
saw Sperm Whales looked for them the fore boat
got one at 4th took the whale along side at 5th saw
a school of Whales coming to leeward bound and chase
talk might come on board but the whale in finished
at 8 PM latter part bailing the 45 miles N of ship
so ends

Sunday May 16th

The first part strong breezes heading to the N.W. at 3 PM saw
school of whale off our weather talk going to windward
could not get near enough to four at 5 PM finished bailing
middle sails close hatches latter part fresh breezes
nothing seen
