SE & E one sail in sight *Se ends*
No. 045 Lat 38.00 Long 34.100

Friday June 4th

The first SE by E middle part have to
bearing SE and latter part SE by E and
ESE at 10 am Flores bearing SE by E by compass
at 12 close in with Point Degada transverse
out of the way as usual *Se ends*

Saturday June 5th

The first part rain squalls spoke Bark Maria
saw 31 months 2.30 hrs off Bark Whiting 5 months
35 hrs at 10 AM went on shore at St Cruz
Se ends

Sunday June 6th

The first part laying off and on at St Cruz
at 5 PM on in hard and steered off shore at
6 AM lower and got 2 Black fish latter part
light air and calm saw Fin backs shaped 4
Parloques Flores bearing NW 15 miles Lat

Monday June 7th

These 24 hours about calm saw Fin back and one
sail nothing worthy of remark *Se ends*
Lat 37.14

Tuesday June 8th

The first part calm latter part light air from W
SE by the wind to the NW saw Fin backs
Jardin sight *Se ends*
Lat 37.14 Long

Wednesday June 9th

The first part light air from the W and at 4
PM backed to the South Flores bearing N.W. Dist
7 miles sailed the Black fish middle part moderate
and thick weather at 7 AM strong breeze from the NW E
SE *Se ends*
Lat 38.51
